English Outcomes: Children will be able to:

- Enjoy a story and discuss its meanings.
- Broaden their understanding of writers' use of language and build a varied vocabulary.
- Use dialogue to move the action along.
- Write a narrative building tension using a variety of techniques.
- Write a newspaper report based on the narrative.

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Year 4!

Maths - Multiplication & Division

Outcomes Children will be able to:

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12.
- Multiply two digit and three digit numbers by a one digit number using formal written layout.
- Solve problems involving multiplying and adding.
- Find the area of rectangles.

Physical Education- Games & Swimming

Children will be learning to:

- Play competitive games and apply basic principles suitable to attacking and defending.
- They will continue to develop their confidence and skills in swimming lessons.

PHSE - Dreams and Goals

Outcomes: Children will learn

- ✓ How to cope with disappointment and how to help others cope with theirs.
- ✓ To know what it is to be resilient and to have a positive attitude.

Computing - Film Project

Outcomes Children will be able to:

- Plan the resources and props they need for a film.
- Use stop motion photography to create a film.
- Edit a film using computer software

International Primary Curriculum (IPC) - Saving the World

Class 4 will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on "Saving the World". This unit of work is part of the International Primary Curriculum(<http://www.internationalprimarycurriculum.com>). During this unit we will be focusing on **Geography and Art**.



We will particularly focus on:

- Where rainforests are in the world
- Which rainforest products we use in our everyday lives
- How and why the rainforest is being destroyed
- The ways that people are trying to save the rainforest.

Science - Looking at States

We will be learning:

- To group materials together, based on observations.
- To measure and research temperatures in degrees Celsius.
- To use research skills to find out about temperature.
- To identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

French

Pupils will be exploring vocabulary for animals and learning to talk about others.

RE

In RE, year 4 will be exploring the question: **How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do?** The children will be learning to understand how celebrating Passover and keeping Kashrut (food laws) helps Jews show God they value their special relationship with Him.
