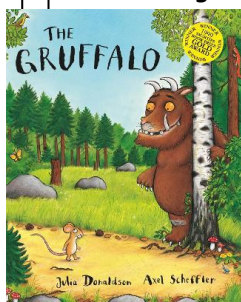


Communication and Language

In Nursery: Use new vocabulary throughout the day.

In Reception: Express their ideas and feelings about their experiences using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tenses and making use of conjunctions.



Understanding the World

In Nursery: Explore the natural world around them, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants.

In Reception: Understand some differences between the natural world and some contrasting environments.

Literacy

In Nursery:

Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing.

In Reception: Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending.

- Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.

Mathematical Development

In Nursery:

Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral.

In Reception:

Explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including evens and odds, double facts and quantities can be distributed equally.

Physical Development

In Nursery: Increasingly be able to use and remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm

In Reception: Begin to show accuracy and care when drawing.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Nursery: Do not always need an adult to remind them of a rule.

In Reception: Explain the reasons for rules, know right from wrong and try to behave accordingly.

Expressive Arts and Design

In Nursery: Begin to develop complex stories using small world equipment like animal sets, dolls and dolls houses etc

In Reception: Share their creations, explaining the process they have used.
