## Class 1&2 Update – Miss Moses


As part of our English topic on the Story Machine - year 1/2 have been designing and building their own machines. We had a lot of fun creating our machines and describing what they do.





## Class Five Artwork Representing God Welcoming Jesus to Heaven










## Word of the Fortnight - Ms Wall


