Children made their own pizzas using the delicious ingredients on offer and then got to sample them. The good news is there was plenty of spare pizza so enough to bring home to share with family and friends.




Cycle Training at St John's

- Providing information about other support services and departments


Our team also runs workshops for parents around the EHCP process, Annual Reviews, and Secondary School Transitions.
