Clearly this isn't just a school problem but in our Federation we are working very hard at helping our children learn the importance of making healthier choices. At breakfast and lunchtime.

Our second session focused on wellbeing which is such an important area. We want the best teachers and support staff to be working with the children so therefore we need to make sure that we are equipping them with the tools and strategies to make sure they are being well looked after. 


Outstanding Work Wall

- Providing information about other support services and departments


Our team also runs workshops for parents around the EHCP process, Annual Reviews, and Secondary School Transitions.
