An update from Mr. Rubin...



Recently pupils visited Morgan Stanley to learn about the importance of finance and the trading market. You can also see them enjoying a challenging game of bench ball.








Class Two Update

- Providing information about other support services and departments


Our team also runs workshops for parents around the EHCP process, Annual Reviews, and Secondary School Transitions.
