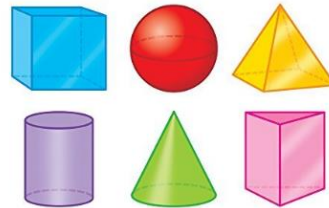

Numeracy

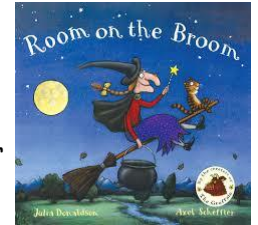
To add and subtract one-digit numbers.
To order numbers, patterns and sequences.
Recognise and name a variety of 2D and 3D shapes.



Outcomes: Children will be able to:
Read, write, count and order numbers to 10 and beyond.
Write number sentences to solve simple addition and subtraction problems accurately.
Discuss the properties of shapes and sort them accordingly.

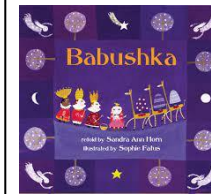
Literacy

Read and write stories which have familiar settings.
Recognise features in books by a particular author -Julia Donaldson.
Use the past tense orally and in writing.
We will write a new part of the story where the witch meets another friend.



Outcomes: Children will be able to:
Use the structure of a story with a familiar setting to help them write their own story.
Use a range of writing styles and punctuation, and read back what they have written.
Orally retell the story.

Religious Education

To learn the key events of the Christian calendar.
To re-tell the Christian Nativity story and decide what gifts would be meaningful for Jesus.

Outcomes:
To know the Nativity story.

Geography

Our geography topic this half term is 'Our School'. Where is our school? Where do we live? What geographical features are around us? Children will learn about the 4 nations of the United Kingdom. They will learn about the 7 continents of the planet Earth.



Geography outcomes:
Name and locate the world's 7 continents.
Devise a simple map.

Physical Education

Gymnastics:
Develop a concept of space and direction.
Use simple gymnastics actions and shapes.
Dance:
Learn a variety of ways to travel.
Connect a short sequence of rehearsed movements.



PSHE

Celebrating Difference.
Outcomes: Understand the ways in which I am special and that we are all different.

Science

Celebrations: We will be thinking about festivals and noting that many of them at this time of year centre around light.



Outcomes:
To understand what a light source is and what causes shadows.

Music: African Drumming

Children will work alongside a specialist teacher to learn African Drumming.

Outcomes: Children will be able to play to the rhythm of a piece of music and learn to follow the beat.

Daily reading: Children need to bring their book bag into school every day. Please spend at least 5 minutes daily reading the phonics book. Repetition is good!

Homework: Year 1 will get spelling homework each Friday. Please use the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write' sheet to practise the 5 words at home. This should take no more than 10 - 15 minutes.
