Time

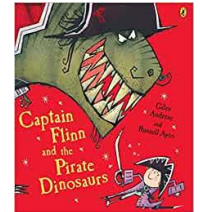
Telling time to the half hour, quarter past and quarter to and to 5 minutes. Comparing durations of time.

Adventure - Captain Flinn and the Pirate Dinosaurs by Giles Andrae



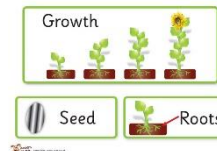
We will be writing:

Topic

Geography - Asia

Key question: What can we learn about the continent of Asia?

We will be using maps, atlases and globes to find and locate the oceans and continents of the world. Using books and the internet, we will be researching countries that are in Asia and finding out information about them. We will be looking at human and physical features of different countries and comparing them to the country we live in.

Parents: How Can You Help?

Reading: Please listen to your child's reading every day. Children in Year 2 have either a guided reading book or a RWI phonics book to read at home with you. They also have a book from the school library. Ask questions about the story and the characters, make predictions, ask 'why do you think...' questions to check their understanding of the story.

Maths: Children in need to learn the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. Please practise this as often as you can - there are lots of online games around times tables facts. Don't forget to use Timetables Rockstars!
