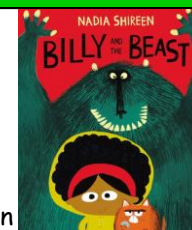
Numeracy

To continue to practise strategies in addition and subtraction
Add and subtract 1s and 10s
Add and subtract 2 digit and 1 digit numbers; and 2 digit and 2 digit numbers
Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p)
Combine amounts to make a particular value
Find totals using different value coins



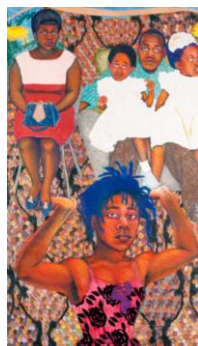
Literacy

We are reading 'Billy and the Beast' by Nadia Shereen
We will be writing character descriptions
Rewriting the story in our own words and writing our own version of this story
We are also looking at Poetry in 'A Great Big Cuddle' by Michael Rosen
We will be looking at noun phrases, verbs and learning about the past progressive form.
We will also be continuing our work on writing sentences with coordination and subordination - e.g. with: and / but / so / because
