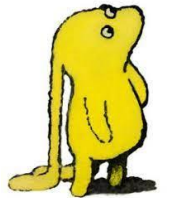


Maths - Place Value / Addition and Subtraction

Represent tens and ones as a part-whole model
Compare and order numbers
Learn addition and subtraction bonds to 20
Add and subtract 1s
Find 10 more and 10 less
