<u>Science - Staying Alive</u> We will learn about the circulatory system, and what blood is made up of. We will learn about the effects of exercise on the body We will be able to explain the effects of smoking, drugs and alcohol on the body. We will be able to look at a range of data and interpret it.	<u>Music - Shadows</u> Our class will continue to learn a repertoire of songs with their work with Mr Cook from the St Paul's Cathedral Choral Programme.		<u>French</u> We will learn how to converse in basic French about shopping.
